

**Graphing Regression Lines in the Graphing Calculator:**

**(Practice with 9.1/9.2 Worksheet #2 or #4)**

- You already have a Regression Line (see “Finding Regression Line” if you don’t have one yet)

Now in the calculator...

**Y=**

Clear out any equations already in there by scrolling up and down, then pressing **CLEAR**

In the first line type in your Regression line (Use **X,T,θ,n** for the variable X)

**ZOOM -- ↓ (Until...) – ZoomFit**

Now you should see a graphed copy of your Regression Line.

\*\*Make sure to turn all StatPlots off prior to graphing Lines. Go to **2<sup>nd</sup> – STATPLOT** to see if any are “ON”, if they are, move up/down and **ENTER** to select each one then highlight over **OFF – ENTER** to turn them off.
